

Downloading the Microsoft Software from ELMS and creating an installation CD or DVD

Prior to downloading the desired software:

1. Make sure you have a CD or DVD drive capable of writing to a blank disc (you will need a blank disc).
2. Download the program [Active@ISO Burner](http://www.ntfs.com/iso-burning.htm) (<http://www.ntfs.com/iso-burning.htm>) which you will use to create your own installation disc. Select the download option in the red box (figure 1).

Downloading the software from ELMS:

Follow the instructions on the ELMS website (http://msdn08.e-academy.com/elms/Storefront/Home.aspx?campus=sdsu_ids). Be sure to write down the Product Key code – you will need it to activate your software. The code will appear as below (in the red box), just prior to downloading the software (figure 2). If you keep the software download options as offered, it will download the software into the C:/Temp directory which will make it easy to locate. The program you download will appear in its own directory. **IMPORTANT:** If there is only one file (ends in .ISO) inside this new directory, you will need to use the following procedure. Otherwise, if there are several files inside the directory, one will be a “setup.exe” file. Just click on that and follow the program instructions.

Most of the Microsoft Software will download as an .ISO file. An .ISO file is a complete image of the disc as if you bought it in a store. Once you download and copy the file to a disc using the procedure below, you can use that disc to install the software. Be sure to save the disc for future reinstalls. Your friends can also use your disc rather than creating one for themselves --- if they have their own Product Key code. Try not to do anything else while the disc is copying as it sometimes may lock up your computer.

Procedure to create installation disk:

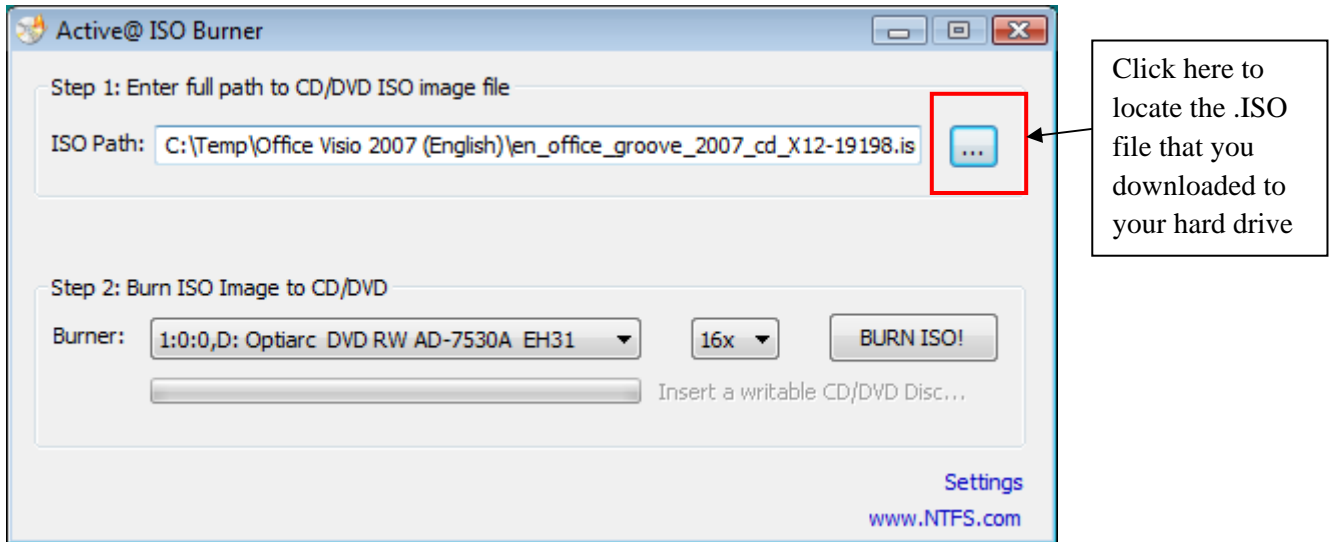


Figure 3. Program to create .ISO disc

1. Open the program, “iso-burner.exe” and follow the instructions (figure 3.)

Installing the program:

1. When the disc copy has completed, open and then close your CD or DVD drive tray to activate it.
2. Enter the Product Key code (figure 4). The Product Key is the “serial number” you copied down from Figure2.
3. Follow the remaining on-screen instructions to complete the installation.

If you forgot to write down the Product Key code:

1. Go to the ELMS site and login.
2. Go to “My Software” red box (figure 5).
3. Then select the download link (red box) as shown in figure 6.
4. Copy the Product code (serial number) as shown in figure 7.

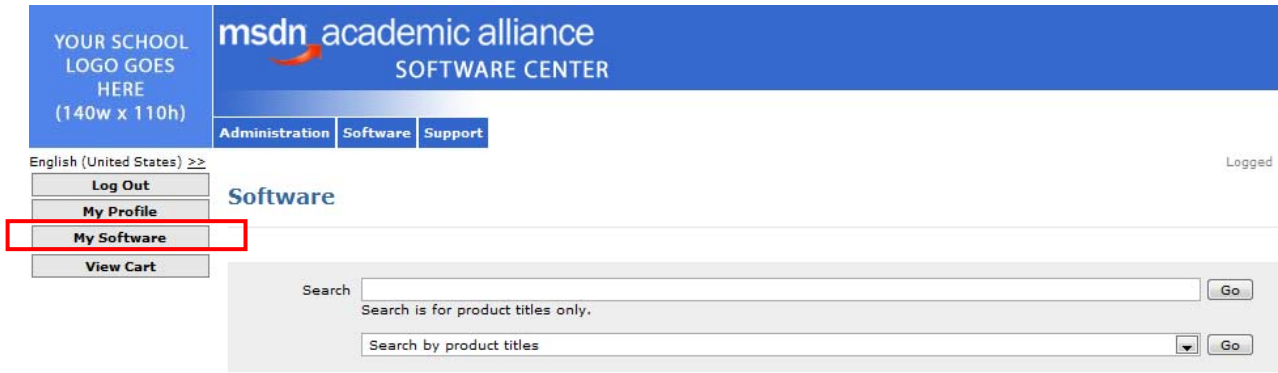

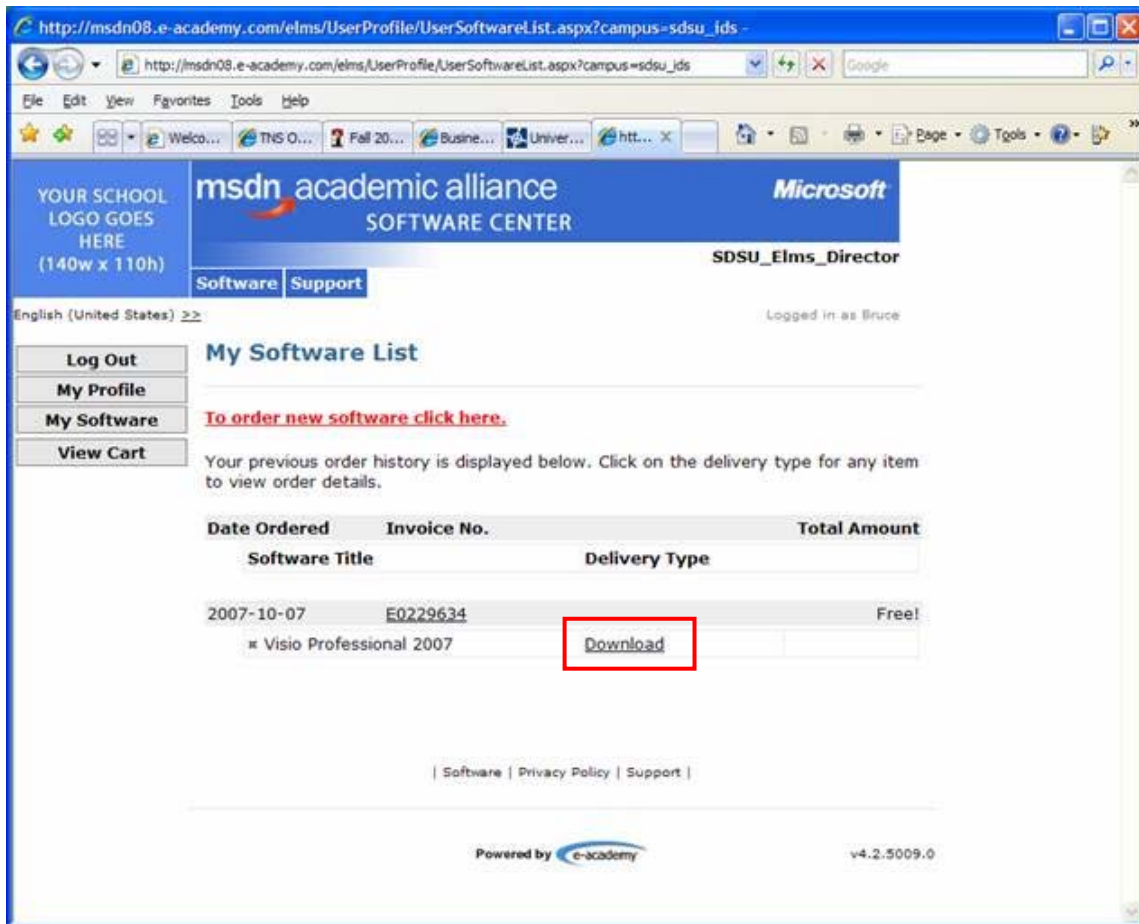
